



Sales Agreement and Program Details

50% Profit! The school or organization earns 50% profit from the merchandise total. A flat \$5 shipping fee will be applied per order regardless of the size of the order.

All you need to do is close the sale; we'll do all the rest. Flower Power Fundraising will provide all of the following services FREE of charge:

- We will send you our full-color 8-page catalogs with a great selection of bulbs and perennials to help you present this earth-friendly program to your organizations.
- We will ship Sales Kits (large poster, collection envelope, master tally/order sheet, chairperson's checklist, and catalogs) directly to the fundraising group.
- We will provide all fulfillment services, including; ship-to-home delivery, order processing, and customer service, including replacements, exchanges, and refunds.

We're going to make it super simple for you. We pay you a 20% commission on the net merchandise total—(total retail less 50% to the schools, exclusive of shipping charges).

You're paid when we're paid. Commissions will be paid once the monies have been received from the school or group doing the fundraiser. Schools or organizations will either pay by credit card directly to Flower Power Fundraising, or send in a check, both for 50% of the merchandise total plus shipping and handling. Profits and commissions are not paid on ship charges. If the organization runs an online program, we will send the profit checks directly to the organization and send you the commission dollars. Commission checks will be processed on a monthly basis after the order ships.

Turnaround. The Spring 2012 fundraising order deadline is April 27, 2012. We will begin shipping orders to customers on April 2, 2012 and continue to ship through mid-May. Once shipping begins, customers can expect to receive their orders within 4 to 12 business days from the date we receive the order from the organization.

Territories. Flower Power Fundraising does not presently offer exclusivity.

Agreement. Flower Power Fundraising agrees to engage your services as an independent contractor to market and sell Flower Power Fundraising products to schools and other organizations, and you accept the roles and responsibilities noted herein and those in the AFRDS code of ethics.

Roles & Responsibilities. You may use your best efforts to market and sell Flower Power Fundraising products and retain full independence in how you provide marketing and sales services to your organizations. We will work in partnership to help you succeed.

Benefits/Taxes. As an independent contractor, you are not eligible to participate in any of the employee benefit plans or programs offered by Flower Power Fundraising. You acknowledge and agree that you are an independent contractor and not an employee of Flower Power Fundraising, that this agreement does not create an employee/ employer relationship. You are responsible for the payment of all appropriate taxes as one who is self-employed.

I acknowledge reading the program details, and by signing, fully accept the roles and responsibilities presented in this agreement, to market and sell Flower Power Fundraising products to customers and to develop customers for Flower Power Fundraising for the duration of this agreement.
